Kristina Partsinevelos is CNBC's Nasdaq reporter, covering the biggest movers in the market with a focus on semiconductors, AI infrastructure and the technology sector. Based at the Nasdaq and CNBC Global Headquarters in Englewood Cliffs, N.J., she delivers real-time reporting across CNBC's television and digital platforms, tracking the companies shaping the next generation of innovation.

Since joining CNBC in May 2021, Partsinevelos has become a key voice on chipmakers, hyperscalers and the evolving AI trade, translating complex supply chain dynamics, earnings moves and policy shifts into clear analysis for investors.

Before CNBC, she spent three years at Fox Business Network as a business correspondent and economist, covering technology, the White House and the Federal Reserve. She also reported from the field during major breaking news events, including the early days of the COVID-19 pandemic in New York City and Hurricane Florence in South Carolina.

Earlier in her career, Partsinevelos reported for Global News in London, BNN Bloomberg, CTV News Channel and CBC Edmonton, covering financial markets and sectors including retail, technology and automotive.

She holds an MBA from the University of Oxford's Saïd Business School and a Master of Journalism from Carleton University. She is fluent in French.
